



Thank you for your interest in Piccola Italia Preschool, offering quality bilingual care and education for children ages 2.9 through 5 years. Let me give your child the gift of acquiring Italian as a second language. Enclosed you will find a brief description of my program, enrollment policies, scheduling options, tuition and other helpful information.

“Piccola Italia,” means “Little Italy,” which often refers to Italian neighborhoods, like the North End in Boston. I chose the name Piccola Italia Preschool (PIP) because it is a little Italian school for little children, originally located in the “Little Italy” of Newton, Massachusetts. I wholly believe that children should start learning their second and third languages early in life; research shows that multilingual children develop a more efficient set of cognitive skills, such as problem solving and abstract thinking, as compared to their monolingual counterparts. In addition to making their brains stronger, learning other languages will make your children more multiculturally aware and curious. Although the curriculum is similar to many preschools, at PIP your children will have the added advantages of learning another language and culture in a small group (ten children or less) and in the familial setting of my home. We have converted two rooms, which are completely separate from the rest of the home, and have been designed to promote independent learning and the acquisition of necessary skills. From art, yoga, and dramatic play to science, math and geography, your children will be educated following PIP’s theme based, emergent style curriculum.

There is an Italian saying that goes: “*Un bimbo che non gioca, felicità ne ha poca,*” which means, “a child who does not play, isn’t too happy” – at PIP we believe that play is the business of childhood. For this reason, we strive for an environment that is happy and engaging, giving your children the tools to learn by doing what they are best at: play!

Enrollment policy

Piccola Italia Preschool welcomes all families to participate in our program regardless of income, nationality, race, ethnic background, disability, marital status, sexual preference, political, or religious beliefs. Our Enrollment policy is one of first come first served, with a priority given to siblings of children currently enrolled in the program. PIP serves children from 2.9 to 5 years of age.

All interested families should complete an Application Form and return it with a nonrefundable registration fee of \$35 (cash or check payable to Rebecca Paxton Cianfrone) as soon as possible.

Upon receipt of your Application Form, I will contact you regarding availability. Confirmations about availability and an Enrollment Packet will be sent out, at which time the Parent/Educator Agreement and a nonrefundable deposit (equal to 25% of your child's first month of tuition) must be submitted. This deposit is to hold your child's space in the program and it will be credited towards the first month's tuition. Spaces are filled on a first come first served basis, as deposits are received.

Tuition Information for the 2020 – 2021 School Year

Tuition is determined according to the number of days per week of attendance. We are open between 8:30am and 4:30pm, Monday-Thursday and between 8:30am and 1:30pm on Friday. Late fees apply to those arriving after 1:30pm (if enrolled in the half day program) and to those arriving after 4:30 (if enrolled in the full day program). Tuition rates are to be paid monthly, due in full according to your contracted schedule by the 20th of the preceding month. For example, October's tuition would be due by September 20th. Extra hours (\$15/hr) may be scheduled as needed, provided there is space, and must be paid in advance.
